The City of Belleville is continuing to deal with the effects of a water main break on Sidney Street in the west part of the City. A boil water advisory is still in effect for the area which includes all properties on Elgin Street, Tripp Avenue, Pepper Avenue, Faraday Gardens, Butler Street, Lake Court and Moira Street West in the vicinity of Elgin Street and Butler Street. Residents are reminded to boil all water used for consumption or to switch to bottled water until the boil water advisory has been removed.

The broken water main has been repaired and the water pressure/conservation concerns are no longer at issue, but the boil water advisory will remain in effect until the City has received satisfactory test results from water samples taken in this area. The public will be notified through a media release as soon as the boil water advisory is no longer required.
